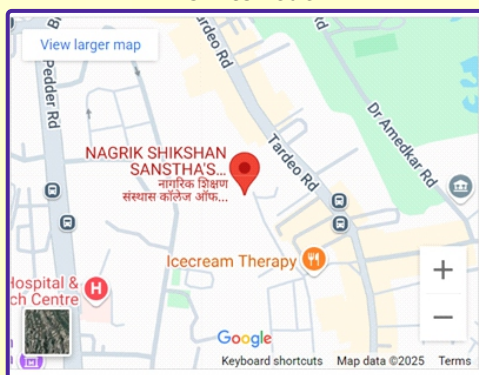

Guidelines for Submission of Papers Abstract

Abstract with key words including the details of all the authors in MS Word, Times New Roman 12pt with 1.5-line spacing **should be submitted on** <https://forms.gle/RfbPWh6fSPvRH9PD6>

Full Length Paper

- ❖ Papers should be original and should not have been published before
- ❖ The full paper should be within 1500-4000 words and references in APA format.
- ❖ Manuscript must be in MS Word, Times New Roman 12pt Font size with 1.5 line spacing, in justify alignment. It should include scope/objectives, methodology, result and discussion.
- ❖ The cover page should include the title of the paper, author and co-author name, college / institute name, mobile number, and email address.
- ❖ The editorial board has the right to reject manuscript.
- ❖ All the papers will be evaluated by reviewers and only the accepted papers will be considered for presentation/publication.
- ❖ Research Papers can be co-authored by more than one author (Max 3 coauthors). Each co-author is required to do separate registration.
- ❖ All the authors/co-authors is required to submit copy-right form while submitting camera-ready paper.
- ❖ Participation/ presentation certificates will be issued.
